INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING DPSRU EIGHTH ANNUAL CONVOCATION

(25.02.2026)

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. The 8th Convocation of the University will be held on 25.02.2026 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. Reporting time for students will be at 9:00 am
2. The Rehearsal of the convocation will be held in the DPSRU University Auditorium on 24.02.2026 at 3:00 pm onwards.
3. All candidates must attend the compulsory Rehearsal failing which they will not be allowed to participate in the Convocation.
4. Entry is strictly through the designated gate only i.e. Gate no 1 for VIPs and Gate no. 2 for all the students/faculty/guests etc.
5. Candidates who are to receive the Degrees/Medals at the Convocation are requested to be punctual for Rehearsal as well as for Convocation.
6. Students should enter the Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi with valid Identification Proof and Badge (provided by the University) on Convocation Day. Students should not carry any eatables/water to the Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
7. Students must occupy their seats by 9:30 a.m. on Convocation Day.
8. Observe silence and maintain proper decorum while in the Hall during the Convocation proceedings
9. Remain seated during Rehearsal and Convocation proceedings.
10. Students must occupy correct seats please note the Row No. and Seat No. allotted on the day of Rehearsal.
11. The candidates are not allowed to use cameras/mobiles during the convocation and will have to either switch off or keep their mobiles on airplane mode.
12. Ph.D. candidates will line up near the dais in batches, in their turns, and will receive their degrees from the Chancellor. Similarly, medals winning candidates.
13. Degrees to all other candidates will be distributed on their seats, in their turns, by the University officials on duty. After receiving the Degrees, candidates are requested to bow to the Chancellor/Vice-Chancellor before taking their seats.
14. In case of any discrepancy in the Degree awarded, the candidate(s) will meet the concerned Assistant Controller of Examinations after the Convocation is over.
15. The discrepancy need not be pointed out during the Convocation, as that may cause unnecessary disturbance in the proceedings of the Convocation.
16. All the candidates for the award of the Degrees and Medals will stand in their seats: Until the procession of the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, members of the various Bodies of the University and other dignitaries enter in the Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi Auditorium and occupy their seats.
17. When National Anthem is being played; No one should leave (Auditorium) until the convocation procession has left.
18. Candidates will proceed for lunch and photography after convocation in two batches. One batch will proceed for group photograph (class wise) and will remain seated in the auditorium. The other batch will proceed for lunch. Instructions will be provided accordingly.

Note: A candidate, who don't bring with him/her the valid Identification Proof and Convocation Badge (provided by the University) and/or does not attend the Rehearsal, will not be allowed to attend the Convocation.





INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING ACADEMIC COSTUME

All dignitaries/on dais, Deans, HoDs, supervisors, faculty and graduands are required to come in prescribed costume at the convocation. No candidate shall be admitted to the Convocation who is not in the prescribed academic dress.

All the candidates must wear the Convocation dress as specified below:

1. Dress Code for Females: -

Cream Kasavu Saree with Maroon Border with half Sleeves off white blouse OR
Off White kameej with off white salwar/chudidar/plajo with off white Dupatta OR
White Shirt with White Trouser. The colour of footwear is Black

2. Dress Code for Males: -

White Kurta with White Pajama/Dhoti
The Colour of Footwear is Black

Note: Turban/Headgear may be of any Colour except Black.
Note: The dress shall be made of Handloom Fabric.

The graduands will be provided a Convocation Sash. The convocation registration fee will cover the cost of sash and no other payment is required.
No graduands will be allowed to attend the convocation ceremony in a dress other than one specified for the convocation.

Information for Sash/Convocation Badge/Food Coupon Collection to Graduating Students

Graduating Students should collect their Registration Badge, Food Coupon, and Convocation Sash on 24th February, 2026 from the Registration Counter, Auditorium, DPSRU, New Delhi (10:00 AM to 02:00 PM). Students should bring the Convocation Registration Proof and a valid ID Proof on the day of Rehearsal on 24th February 2026 at DPSRU, New Delhi and also on the day of 8th Convocation, 25th February, 2026 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. The Graduating Students will retain the Convocation Sash.

Note: A help desk will be available near Gate No.02, Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on the day of the Convocation.



Instructions -Discipline Committee

All graduating students are required to strictly adhere to the following instructions to maintain the dignity and decorum of the Convocation Ceremony.

1. Late entry will not be permitted under any circumstances.
2. Students must carry Valid University ID card and Convocation entry pass.
3. Follow the instructions of volunteers and security personnel.
4. Student should Maintain proper queue and discipline at all times specially during convocation ceremony at Auditorium, Photography and during Lunch
5. Students must occupy only the seats allotted to them.
6. No change of seating without permission is allowed
7. Maintain silence after taking your seat.
8. Mobile phones must be kept on **silent mode**.
9. No phone calls inside the ceremony hall.
10. No selfies or photography during the ceremony unless permitted.
11. Stand up when instructed (e.g., National Anthem, Academic Procession).
12. Maintain complete silence and decorum.
13. Do not shout, clap excessively, or create disturbance.
14. Follow the sequence when your name is announced.
15. Walk calmly to the stage and return to your seat immediately after receiving your degree.

- Nearest Metro Station: Central Secretariat (Yellow & Violet Line)

Reporting Time

- All participants are requested to report at least 120 minutes prior to the scheduled program time.
- Late entry may not be permitted due to security protocols.

Entry & Security Protocol

- Original Badge/ Invite (issued by University) and Photo ID is mandatory (Aadhar Card / Passport / Driving License / Official ID/ University ID).
- Entry is strictly through the designated gate only i.e. Gate no 1 for VIPs and Gate no. 2 for All Others
- Security screening is compulsory for all attendees.
- No belongings except a mobile phone are allowed.

Restricted Items

The following items are not permitted inside the premises:

- Laptops
- Pen drives / Storage devices
- Cameras (without prior approval)
- Sharp objects / Metallic items
- Outside food & beverages

Important Note

- Children below the age of 14 years are not permitted inside the premises



TRANSPORT / TRAVELLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

Students are advised to carefully read and follow the instructions mentioned below:

1. Students are advised to travel through public transport or hired vehicles as there is restricted parking [Nearest metro on Violet Line is Khan Market Metro Station (0.98 KM) and on Yellow line Seva Teerth (Udyog Bhawan) Metro Station (1.24 KM)].
2. If students are coming by their personal vehicle, they must arrange parking on their own.
3. Entry of the students will be through Gate No. 2 only, with valid ID cards/badges issued by the University.
4. After entering through Gate No. 2, Candidates are requested to follow the signage instructions provided at the venue.
5. For security reasons, no water bottles or any edible items are allowed inside the premises.
