Parliamentary Question, Point No.7

Upon careful analysis of the data provided w.r.t percentage of SC/ST among teaching/non teaching staff in colleges under the jurisdiction of Delhi Government, it is evident that requisite percentage of SCs and STs is not being met in these colleges especially among the teaching staff. It is pertinent to mention that Guru Gobind Singh Inderprastha University, a renowned university in Delhi, holds NIL percentage of SC/ST in teaching staff. Such figures present a grim picture about representation/ reservation of SCs/STs in the faculty side of the colleges under the jurisdiction of Delhi government. The Committee is perplexed to note that in metro cities like Delhi where trained professionals of SC/ST categories are in abundance, there should be no dearth of well qualified and deserving SC/ST candidate for teaching posts. The Committee would like to be apprised of the reasons for such shortfall and remedial action being taken thereon. The Committee urges the Delhi Government to seek corrective action taken report from various colleges under its jurisdiction in this regard and submit to the Committee within a period of 3 months.
